At Leven CE (VC) Primary School we have a raft of initiatives which are deployed to support children to ‘bridge the gap’ in performance. The Pupil Premium funding therefore was used to pay for in 2015/16 and 2016/17 as appropriate:

- 1 to 1 tuition in English and Maths
- Small Group Work
- Specific intervention programmes e.g supporting children to overcome problems caused by Dyslexia
- Booster Classes in English and Maths
- Additional Teaching Assistant Support
- Social Language Groups
- School visits / residential visits
- Uniform
- Outside experts / artists to work with children

#### Impact of Pupil Premium

The support put in place, as appropriate, for children receiving Pupil Premium Funding results in most of these children making expected or above expected progress. Most of the pupils are also working at or above age related expectations. Again, when they aren’t, they are targeted for additional support.

Close observation of the results achieved by children receiving Pupil Premium Funding ensures that if a child should show signs of falling behind, they are provided with the necessary support offered by one of our interventions

**Impact of Pupil Premium**

The support put in place, as appropriate, for children receiving free school meals results in most of these children making expected or above expected progress.
